Father Kumeran, who prayed at many of the holy places of Hinduism in India and the Christianity in the West, will share his experiences of these holy places, the rich stories behind these places of pilgrimage and their spiritual and esoteric significance.

This will include places like the ancient city of Vanarasi, the sacred river Ganga, the temples of the great Goddess, the sacred mountain Arunachala, the temple of the dancing God in Chidambaram and places linked to the Christian faith such as Jerusalem, Assisi and Lourdes.

Father Kumeran will use these Holy Places as sacred metaphors to help us discover a path to the holiest place of pilgrimage **"the inner sanctuary of our heart "**

In this retreat, prayers, guided meditations, songs and rituals will be offered for support teaching.

Father Kumeran, of Indian origin, lives in South Africa. Called to follow Jesus, he became an Anglican priest. Then his spiritual search led him to leave his church for a contemplative life in South India at the foot of the sacred mountain Arunachala. He reconciles there its Hindu and Christian roots. Another call leads him to testify and transmit the richness of his spiritual discoveries.

He founded and directed Arunachala Marga (the Way of Arunachala), which celebrates above all the achievement of the Divine Light in oneself and inter-religious dialogue. Invited by "Chemins de Shanti" which promotes encounters between Christian spirituality and the wisdom of India, Father Kumeran has been teaching in France since several years.
